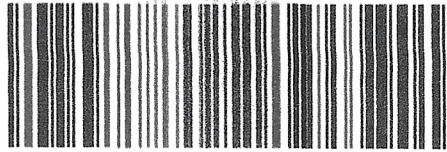

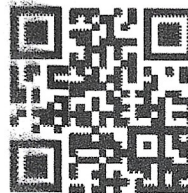

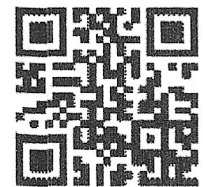

**Interest**
