

Making Estimated Tax Deposits for Individual/1040's


1. Go to www.irs.gov and click on "Payments"




2. Click on "IRS Direct Pay"



3. Click on "Make a Payment"



4. Under "Reason for Payment" click "Estimated Tax". It should auto fill the other two, but make sure they are showing "1040ES" and the current year.



5. After you confirm, you must verify your identity. The "Tax Year for Verification" field is the tax year of a return that you want them to use to verify your identity. It is usually best to go with the latest year that you filed a return. The rest of the fields confirm what you put on that return, not necessarily what the current information is.


Direct Pay verifies your identity using information from your 1040 filing history. Please provide the following information from a 1040 tax return you filed during the previous six years.

Note: the Tax Year for Verification you enter here does not have to match the tax year for your payment.



6. Next, fill in your payment information.

The payment date below is the date you will get credit for the payment. If your payment is due today, schedule the next business day for your payment to avoid penalties and interest.



7. Accept the Debit Authorization Agreement and fill in your name & SSN; click Submit
